The Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) has completed the review of your Application for Change in Educational Objectives and supplemental documentation in support of the application received on May 24, 2018. Pursuant to California Education Code (CEC) section 94894 and California Code of Regulations (5, CCR) section 71650, the Bureau has determined that your application demonstrates, in addition to the other requirements for granting a change in educational objectives, that the institution meets the requirements for a provisional approval pursuant to CEC section 94885.5, and the Bureau approves the institution's accreditation plan pursuant to 5, CCR section 71105.

Provisional approval may be granted to no more than two degree programs (CEC section 94885.5). Provisional approval to add only the following program(s) has been granted effective October 25, 2018.

- Associate of Science in Health Science – 60 units
- Associate of Arts in Business Administration – 60 units

Students seeking to enroll shall be notified in writing, in the format required by 5, CCR, section 71775, prior to the execution of an enrollment agreement, that the institution's provisional approval to offer a degree program is contingent upon California Preparatory College being subsequently accredited. Further, pursuant to CEC section 94885.5(b)(3), within two years of this provisional approval, or by October 25, 2020, California Preparatory College must show evidence that a completed application for accreditation with the required fee was submitted and accepted by the accreditor. California Preparatory College must also show evidence of achieving full accreditation within five years of provisional approval, or by October 25, 2023. Failure to meet these deadlines will result in an automatic suspension pursuant to CEC section 94885.5(c). An institution that elects to stop offering its degree program(s) or stops pursuing accreditation, or that becomes automatically suspended, must, among other things, cease enrolling students and


provide the Bureau with a degree program closure plan pursuant to 5, CCR section 74250.

Your institution's Change in Educational Objectives application for provisional approval and accreditation plan is subject to further review by a visiting committee. The institution is also subject to review by Bureau staff at any time for the purpose of monitoring compliance with the provisions of the California Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009. Any failure to maintain compliance could affect your institution's approval status and could result in disciplinary action by the Bureau.

Please post this approval information along with the "Notice to Prospective Degree Program Students" in a prominent location so that prospective students and other interested parties are aware of your provisional approval to offer degree programs.
