CNA Program Summary

An Adventist Health-branded, 12-week online educational program to recruit, train and hire needed CNAs.

CDPH approved online classes of 18 modules will be taught via synchronous instruction - a live video-conferenced lecture in real time.

Instructors are registered nurses

Classes in the evenings and on Sundays

Clinical Training Site at AH Sonora SNF

Currently in process of state approval for online instruction (tentative approval date March or April 2022).

Requirements

- **Medical Exam (including TB test) & LiveScan Background Check**
- **Minimum Age of 18 and employment eligible at time of course completion**
- **Reliable Computer and Internet Access**
- **High School Diploma or GED Preferred**
- **Virtual Interview & Completed Registration Form and Documents**

Length of Program

- **12-week program**
- **62 hours didactic online training**
- **100 hours of clinical training at SNF**

Size of Program

- Cohorts of 15 students per class
- Up to 3 cohorts per year at Adventist Health clinical facility

Instruction

- The theory/didactics component of the program consists of 17 modules and one AH Mission Integration module
- Following completion of the first nine modules (approximately 18 hours of theory), students begin the clinical skills portion of the required 100 hours of training at the AH Sonora SNF.
- Each module test must be passed to continue to next module
- Attendance is mandatory and any absence must be made up in week 12 or as arranged with instructor

Tuition/Cost

- **Tuition: \$1,800** (Adventist Health Scholarships May be Available)
- **Cost of textbook included**
- **Additional Costs** (approx \$175)
 - Cost of uniform/scrubs as required by clinical facility (and comfortable, closed toe shoes)
 - Stethoscope
 - Cost of highlighters, note-taking supplies (i.e. paper, post-it flags, notebook/3-ring binder, pens/pencils, etc.)
 - Cost of face coverings or PPE to be worn during clinical instruction are paid for by the Adventist Health clinical facility

Misc. Details

- Designed for candidates seeking nurse assistant certification in California and to pass the National Nurse Aide Assessment Program (NNAAP®) Examination.
- Custom AH Mission Integration module added to program
- Taught by Registered Nurses approved by the California Department of Public Health
- Convenient evening and Sundays schedule making it easier for the working adult
- Full scholarships may be available through Adventist Health for qualified students
